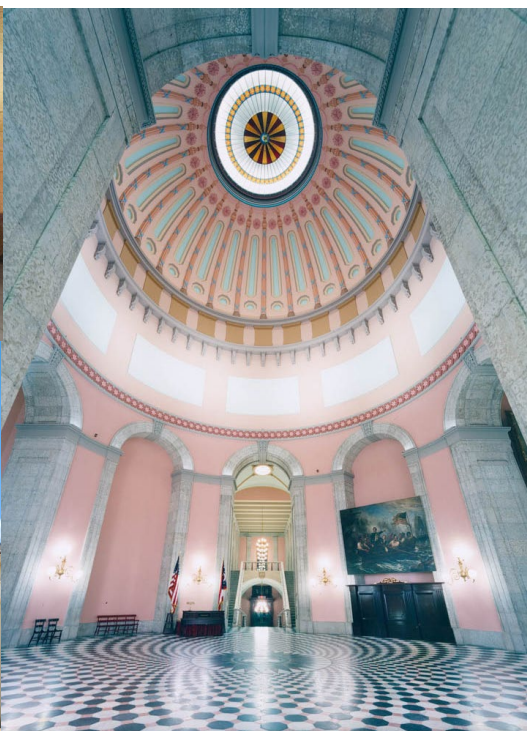

At his Welker Studio, he creates large-scale suspended public art and temporary installations that are exhibited nationally.
